- run sport competitions or increase pupils' participation in the [School Games](#)*
- run sports activities with other schools*

Impact of Sports Funding 2013/2014

Gymnastics

Questionnaires completed by staff show a substantive difference between their knowledge and confidence in Gymnastics before and after the CPD provision provided by our Specialist Teacher. All feel better equipped to teach the specific areas covered during the 6 week period and have requested a further period of training in the next year covering a different unit of Gymnastics. In the next tranche of training there will be more emphasis on teachers taking the lesson and the Specialist Teacher observing and highlighting areas for improvement.

Outcomes for children were observed to be markedly better as the level of challenge was much higher given that the Specialist Coach had very high expectations of all classes, even the very youngest children in the school.

Swimming

Year 3 to 6 children swim each year in the Summer term using the pool at our neighbouring secondary school.

In recent years we have noticed that more and more of our children are non-swimmers when they begin swimming lessons in Yr 3. This has meant that staff have had to teach children to swim from scratch and many expressed concerns about whether they were doing this correctly. This Summer we employed a specialist instructor to provide CPD in this area. Questionnaires completed by staff show a marked improvement in their confidence in teaching this skill to children.

Assessment shows that the majority of non-swimmers were able to one width of the pool independently.

Football

Due to staffing changes in the last 2 years we have not provided a football after school club to our children. Sports funding has meant that we have been able to use Grimsby Town Football Coaches to run a club for children from Year 1 to Yr 6 during the Spring and Summer terms. 37 children accessed this provision.

In addition, we have used Sports Funding to employ JB Sports who have worked with the youngest children in school on the first kick programme. This has taken place over the Spring and Summer Term. 45 places were taken up by this cohort. Feedback from these children has been extremely positive and 100% of them have said they will continue with football in Yr 1.

Summer Clubs

A 3 day multi skills club run by Grimsby Town Football Coaches took place for all Yr groups during the Summer holidays. This was attended by 38 children and the feedback from all children was extremely positive.

In addition to this we targeted our more able PE students to attend a Summer Sports Club run by JB Sports Coaching. This was attended by 58 children and feedback from children was very positive.

Transport and Fixtures
