‘Schools can choose how they use the funding, for example to:

- hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers during PE lessons
- support and involve the least active children by running after-school sports clubs and holiday clubs, e.g. the [Change4Life](#) clubs
- provide resources and training courses in PE and sport for teachers
- run sport competitions or increase pupils’ participation in the [School Games](#)
- run sports activities with other schools

Funding for the academic year 14/15 will come through in two tranches: Sept 14 to Mar 15 £5784 and April 15 to August 15 £3,925. We are now led to believe that this level of funding will continue through to March 2019.
